

YEAR 5/6 OAK AUTUMN 2 2023 CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER

This half term our curriculum theme is the Anglo-Saxons. Our enquiry question is: **How did the Anglo-Saxons change Britain?**

ENGLISH - WRITING

In writing lessons the children will be learning how to write a newspaper article. In grammar lessons, the children will learn how use relative clauses and parenthesis to add extra detail.



History

In History, children will learn about the key events that led to the end of Roman Rule in Britain. They will also explore where the Anglo-Saxons came from and why they chose to settle in Britain. They will learn about the changes to social structure, rule and religion that occurred during this period, whilst also learning about the origin of the name 'England.'

RELGIOUS EDUCATION How do beliefs shape identity for Muslims?

The children will continue to explore the Islamic faith learning about key beliefs. They will learn about the significance of the Mosque and the Qu'ran in the life of muslims.



ENGLISH - READING

This half term the children will be improving the accuracy of their response in retrieval questions. They will be highlighting key words in the questions, referring back to the text and considering what type of an answer is required. We will also be learning how to select relevant quotations to support our answers.

SCIENCE

In Science lessons the children will be learning about light. They will explore how we see, learn how light travels, explore reflection and refractions. As part of their learning, they will also be planning and conducting practical investigations to further their understanding of how light travels.

COMPUTING

The children will be learning about how to design a web-page.



The children will be learning numbers 1-10, colours. and animals.



MATHEMATICS

Working within their year group level, the children will be working upon maths units focusing upon calculating using the four operations, developing their written and mental strategies. They will also continue to develop their basic number skills in daily arithmetic sessions.

D&T

This half term the children will b will learn how to sew two pieces of fabric together using blanket stitch, and cerate a Christmas decoration..

PE

In PE the children will be developing their skills in netball and volleyball.

PSHE

The children will be following unit of work called 'Celebrating Differences'.
